


Welcome to Nextera – We are excited to have you as a new subscriber.

Installation Steps

- 1. Remove the Nextera Phone Adapter from the shipping box you received.
- 2. Disconnect the power from all devices on your network including your cable/DSL modem, router, and computer(s).
- 3. Insert one end of the Ethernet cable (included) into the Ethernet port of the adapter.



- 4. If you are not sharing the broadband connection with any computer(s), then:
 - Connect the other end of the Ethernet cable to your DSL/cable modem.

or

If you <u>are</u> sharing the broadband connection with any computer(s), then:

- Connect the other end of the Ethernet cable to the LAN port of your router.
- Connect an Ethernet cable from the cable/DSL modem's Ethernet port to the WAN port of the router.
- 5. Connect a telephone to the PHONE1 port of the Adapter using a standard phone line.



- 6. Connect the appropriate power cable to the cable/DSL modem. Wait about two minutes for the cable/DSL modem to boot up before continuing.
- 7. Connect the appropriate power cable to the router (if used). Wait about two minutes for the router to boot up before continuing.
- 8. Connect the power cable provided with the Adapter to the POWER port on the Adapter. Wait at least five minutes for the Adapter to boot up. The Adapter's blue status light will blink in sequence until it has fully connected to the Nextera network.



9. Once the Adapter's blue status light is solid, the Adapter is ready to use! Pick up your telephone receiver and begin making calls.

Connect an Ethernet cable from the LAN ports on the router to each of your computers. Power up each computer. Your Internet connection should work as it did before you installed the Phone Adapter.

Status/Link LED Blink Patterns

Power LED

- .Off = Power Off
- .**Solid Blue** = Power On/Device Ready
- .Blue Blinking = Booting/System Self-Test/ Firmware Upgrade
- .Solid Red = Power On Self-Test Failure/Device Malfunction

Ethernet LED

- .Off = No Ethernet Connection
- .Solid Blue = Ethernet Connection Established
- .Blue Blinking = Data Sending/Receiving

Phone1/Phone2 LED

- .Off = Phone Not In Use/Not Provisioned or Registered
- .Solid Blue = Phone Connection Established
- .Blue Blinking = Phone In Use/Incoming Call Detected
